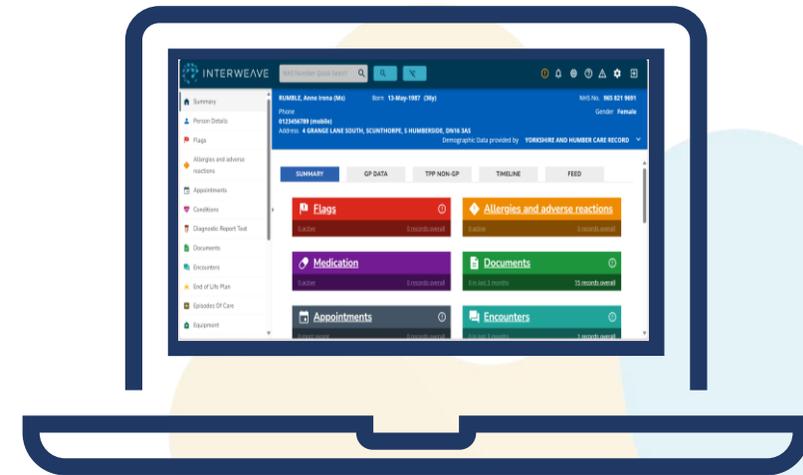
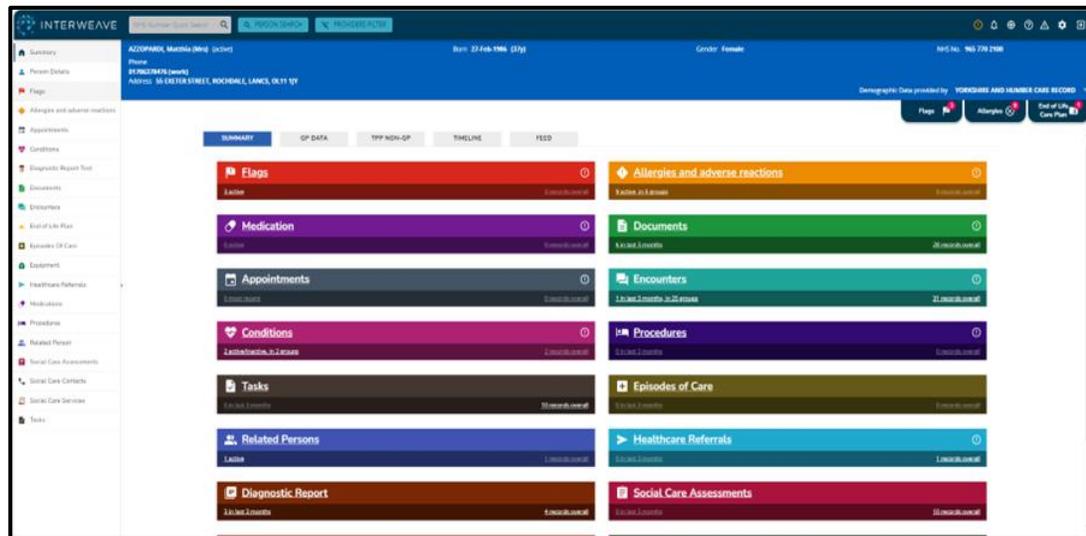

What, Why and When?

- The objective of the HCV Shared Care Record programme is to leverage the regions commitment to the YHCR programme to provide the **right information**, to the **right person**, at the **right time**.
- The **Yorkshire & Humber Care Record (YHCR) Interweave Portal** will become a fully integrated health and social care record for patients and citizens across the Yorkshire and Humber region to support care and will be made available to all GPs across Humber and North Yorkshire (HNY)
- This improves the health and wellbeing of our people by **safely and securely** connecting health and care organisations so that **real time data** is available to clinical and care staff involved in a person's care.
- The YHCR Interweave Portal will provide practices a single place to access patient information from different health & care providers.

Go-Live Practice Checklist

- Nominate** a Practice Lead
- Review and sign** a new Information Sharing Agreement (ISA) and Data Processing Agreement (DPA)
- Complete** New User Request Form
- Inform** all appropriate practice staff about the portal
- Adopt** Communication Toolkit
- Participate** in Training and cascade training materials
- Amend /update** Fair Processing / Privacy Notices on practice website
- Display** promotional material and add information to practice website
- Complete** configuration of contextual launch (*SystemOne Practices only*)
- Inform** practice users of account set-up requirement e.g. self-registration or email verification

Portal User Account set-up requirement

SystemOne Sites

- The YHCR central team will notify the Practice SystemOne Administrator who was named on the completed **User Request Form** of the Contextual Launch configuration information (specific Key, IV number and URL). *Please note, approximate time required for initial set-up by SystemOne Administrator is between 3 and 5 mins.*
- Once the contextual launch has been configured by the SystemOne Administrator, users will be prompted to self-register. They will need to enter their username (NHSmail email address) and a new password, followed by their First Name and Last Name. *Please note, approximate time required for individual user set-up is 3 to 5 minutes.*

EMIS Sites

- All individuals who were included on the **User Request Form** will receive an email from **care.portal** once their account has been set-up by the YHCR Central Team.
